Sadly, speeding continues to be excessive. Church Causeway has surpassed previous records with over 88% exceeding 20mph and a top speed of 76mph. The percentage exceeding 30mph is similar at around 46% although there is a slight dip in December as there were less cars that month.

Walton Road also recorded a record top speed of 73mph, although the percentage exceeding 30mph has reduced further to 32% for December although there are also less cars recorded in this month.

### **Dog Fouling**



We have received a number of complaints from residents about the increasing problem of uncollected dog foul in and around the village. Some parts of the village are worse than others. We have placed a number of signs in the area to try and remind

residents to pick up after their dog.

Uncollected waste can be a hazard, particularly for young children. It is a public nuisance and unsightly. Furthermore, it is an offence for a person who is in charge of a dog to allow it to foul on land which is open to the air, then fail to remove it immediately. Being unaware of the fouling, whether by not being in the area or otherwise, or not having a suitable means of removing the faeces, is not a reasonable excuse for failing to remove it.
